Location

Situated at Silverstone Circuit, the home of British motorsport, on the site of the 1999 WRC Rally of Great Britain special stage, the centre overlooks Hangar Straight on the Grand Prix circuit.

A purpose built centre dedicated to driver excellence. The main building includes a display atrium, a superb restaurant with panoramic views of the Porsche Test Track, an innovative Human Performance Centre and state-of-the-art meeting and conference facilities.

The proximity of the Grand Prix circuit allows a seamless progression from B road handling circuit to race track, where Porsche's underpinning sports car focus is clearly demonstrated and is equally at home in both environments.



Test Tracks

A complex and interesting layout of corners and cambers using the natural topography of the land. We have created a series of tracks to challenge both car and driver that rewards good technique and skill. Using the latest technology and specially constructed surfaces we are able to replicate wet, ice and snow conditions.

Split into four defined areas, each allows a different aspect of road craft to be analysed, understood and mastered. With a self imposed maximum of 16 cars on track at any one time, this means you get the maximum time and space to explore the capabilities of track, car and driver without hindrance.

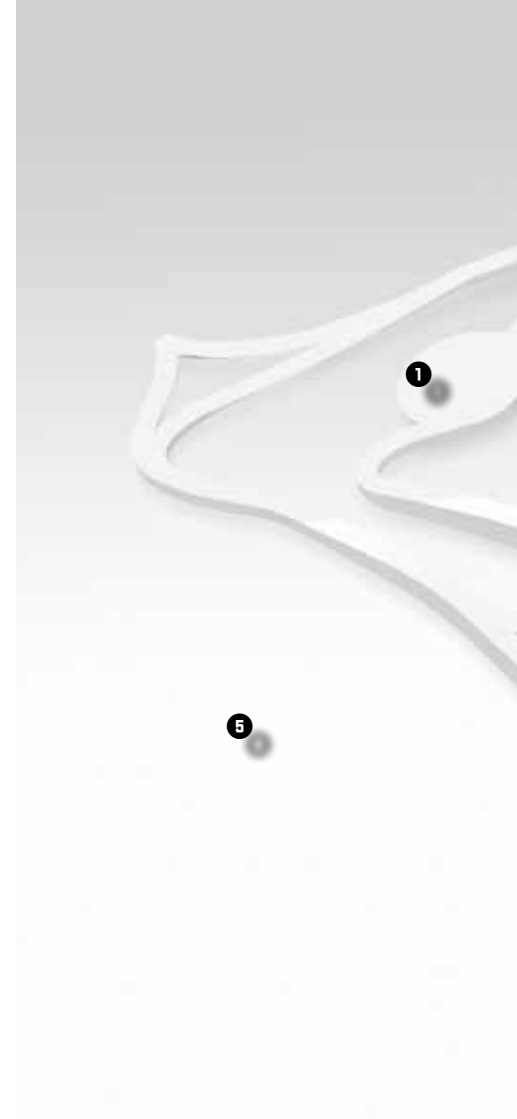

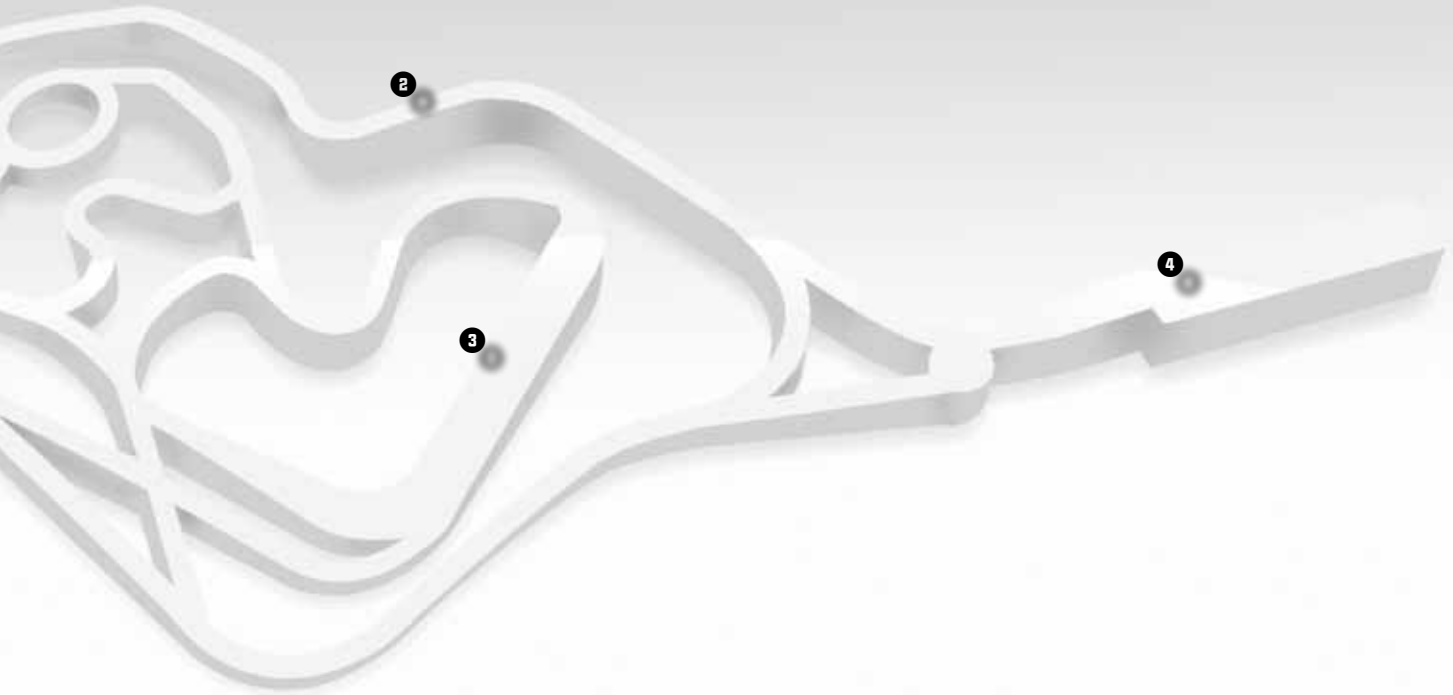

Handling Circuit

The Handling Circuit has been designed not as a race track but as a challenging country road, the natural environment of Porsche. Using the contours of the land we have created a flowing series of corners and undulations that all offer very different challenges for both car and driver.

You will learn the correct lines, braking points and how to safely extract the maximum enjoyment from your driving experience.





Ice Hill

A 7% slope, computer-controlled water jets and a low friction surface. A combination which provides a unique and challenging scenario to test even the most experienced of drivers. But as you begin to appreciate the handling characteristics of the car its a challenge you'll find addictive.





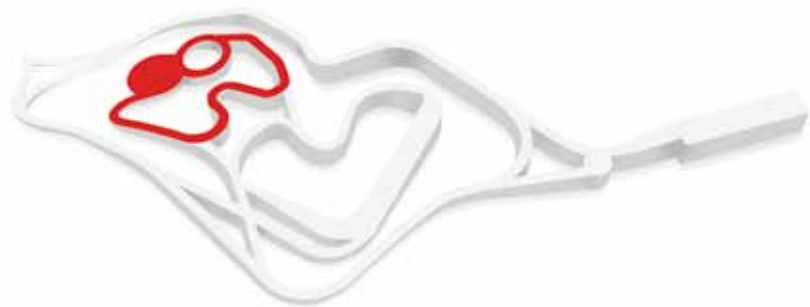

Low Friction

A combination of close proximity bends made of a highly polished limestone create an ideal environment to provoke, correct and hold oversteer all at speeds which enable you to build an understanding of car dynamics.



Kick Plate

A computer-controlled hydraulic plate set flush to the road surface is designed to induce loss of rear wheel traction, putting the car into a skid or spin. You will be taught the correct technique to 'catch' the slide and bring the car under control (but maybe not the first time).

This area is designed to show how the technical systems on the Porsche Cayenne work in off-road conditions. With 45% declines and ascents, rough terrain and unfeasible side slopes that challenge even the most focused 4x4s, the Cayenne is more than capable of conquering the toughest obstacles.

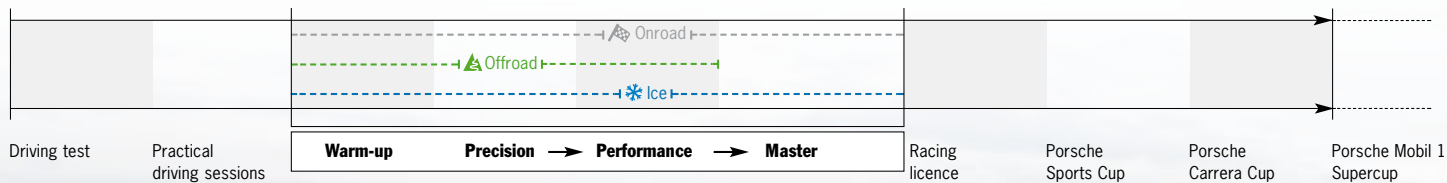

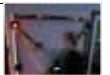

Porsche Travel Club has put together a range of outstanding driver training courses for maximum enjoyment – on road, off road and on ice.

Camp4

You can visit Camp4 and improve your driving skills at the Arctic Circle in Finland, namely at the Arctic Driving Centre or the Mellatracks Proving Ground. Take to the wheel of a 911 Carrera or Cayenne and hone your car control skills on ice and snow. Experience all types of potentially hazardous conditions including a black-ice slalom, off-road circuit and skid pad with the benefit of expert guidance from Porsche instructors.

Camp4S

Once you have mastered the challenges at Camp4, you can go on to test your limits at Camp4S. On these courses, the training sections are even more demanding. Camp4S includes a quick recap of the basics, as well as detailed theory sessions and driving at higher speeds. Briefings are held on two evenings in preparation for the next day's driving.

Ice Force

On a frozen lake 300km inside the Arctic Circle in northern Finland, you can develop your techniques and skills in icy conditions to master-level. Under the instruction of experienced tutors and in a safe environment, participants can explore the handling of selected Cayman and 911 models to their limits, learning how to control - and create - understeer and oversteer, with and without

electronic safety aids activated. Find out how to make a Porsche dance on ice.

Desert Camp Dubai

For a complete contrast, you can put the Cayenne through its paces in the desert of Dubai. At Desert Camp Dubai, you will receive a brief introduction to desert driving on the sand dunes near Al Madam. After a practice session, follow an experienced guide on a desert safari through the seemingly endless dunes.

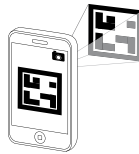
