
Porsche Cayenne – Service Intervals

There are two types of Porsche services, a minor and a major service, both of which are required at different intervals.

Additionally to these services your Porsche Cayenne may require some further maintenance at certain points of the vehicles lifecycle.

Below is an indicative timeline of the care and maintenance your Cayenne requires at different times during its lifetime. Servicing your Cayenne at the required intervals will ensure your vehicle continues to deliver optimum performance.

Minor service for your Porsche Cayenne

What's included

Matching the strong reputation of Porsche for its leading-edge engineering capabilities, we have introduced a 30,000 km / 2 year service interval for our most recent Cayenne models.

(Please refer to your Driver's Manual for your particular Cayenne service interval requirement.)

Every minor service is carried out by a Porsche-trained technician and covers the following:

Electrics	Windscreen wiper/washer system, headlight cleaning system: check operation and nozzle settings
	Horn: check operation
	Diagnostic system: read out fault memory; reset maintenance interval
Outside the vehicle	Check wiper blades
	All headlights: check adjustment
	Battery and vent hoses: check functional state and fluid level
	Exterior of tyres and spare wheel: check condition and tyre pressure

Under the vehicle	Radiators and air inlets: visual inspection for external contamination and blockage
	Drain engine oil, replace oil filter
	Brake lines: visual inspection for damage, routing and corrosion
Engine compartment	Drive shafts: visual inspection of the boots for leaks and damage
	Drain water from fuel filter (Cayenne Diesel only)
	Top up engine oil
	Coolant: check level and antifreeze

Major service for your Porsche Cayenne

What's included

Recent innovations in reliability and technology have enabled Porsche to introduce a service interval of 60,000 km or 4 years on its most recent Cayenne models for a major service.

(Please refer to your Driver's Manual for your particular Cayenne service interval requirement.)

As time and distance between services has generally increased, so has the importance of these services. Every minor service is carried out by a Porsche-trained technician and covers the following:

Additional maintenance work

Depending on the age of your vehicle, your Cayenne may require some additional maintenance work. Those items covered are priced individually and may include:

	Point of time
Replace spark plugs (not on Cayenne Diesel)	Every 60,000 km or every 4 years*
Replace PDCC reservoir	Every 90,000 km or every 6 years
Air cleaner: replace filter element (Cayenne Diesel only)	Every 90,000 km or every 6 years
Air cleaner: Replace air-cleaner element (Cayenne (V6), S, Turbo, S Hybrid)	Every 120,000 km or every 6 years
All-wheel final drive: change oil	Every 240,000 km or every 16 years
Rear final drive: change oil	Every 240,000 km or every 16 years
Transfer gear: Change oil (Cayenne Diesel, S Hybrid, V6)	Every 240,000 km or every 16 years
Manual transmission: change oil	Every 240,000 km or every 16 years
Tiptronic transmission: change ATF and ATF filter	Every 240,000 km or every 16 years
Change brake fluid (use only original Porsche brake fluid)	Every 2 years
Complete Condition Report for Long-Life Guarantee	Every 2 years
Clutch: Change brake fluid; perform test and adaptation (Cayenne S Hybrid)	Every 2 years
Replace tyre sealant	Every 4 years

Any additional work required will be individually quoted and fully discussed with you prior to any work commencing.

Brake fluid change

Over time, your vehicle's brake fluid absorbs moisture from the air. The resulting accumulation of water lowers the boiling point and, under certain operating conditions, can affect the braking action. Therefore, in order to ensure your Porsche Cayenne continues to provide optimum braking in all conditions, the brake fluid should be changed in accordance with the change intervals stated in your Driver's Manual**.

Oil change

Engine oil lubricates and removes heat from internal engine components. The oil filter removes harmful deposits from the engine oil, preventing them from being circulated throughout the engine. The oil change is included in the minor and the major service. Nevertheless, Porsche recommends replacing the engine oil and the oil filter every 15,000 km or every year.

* For Cayenne Turbo every 45,000 km or every 4 years

** As the brake fluid change interval is independent of the vehicle's mileage, it may fall outside of a minor or major service.

Final test drive


Only so much of the condition of your vehicle can be assessed in our workshop and the final test drive, which takes place after the work has been carried out, will confirm that your car is ready to be handed back to you.

Items tested during the test drive include:

- Remote control
- front seats
- foot and parking brake
- engine
- clutch
- steering
- transmission
- park assist
- speed control
- PSM switch
- PASM switch
- sport switch
- heating and air conditioning system
- instruments

Finally, a visual inspection for leaks, oils and fluids is carried out.
